

IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT

I am a UCR employee, what do I do if a federal agent comes seeking to enter a nonpublic or limited access area of my workspace with a warrant or subpoena?

1. Call the Office of Legal Affairs at (951) 827-5983
2. Call UCPD at (951) 827-5222
3. Ask for the agent's name, ID number, agency affiliation, and business card
4. Ask to see the documentation
5. Inform the agent that you are not obstructing their process and need to consult with campus counsel because you are not authorized to give consent to access persons or buildings
